



Figure 2. Jonathan⁷ Riggs and his wife, Polly.




Figure 4. North Carolina in 1775




Figure 5. Tryon Co., N.C., waterways, north to the left. Sandy Run above and slightly right of "Rutherford Co" (with that phrase horizontal).

Sandy Run at top (or right, if viewed horizontally).




Figure 7. Thomas 8 (left) and Timothy Ambrose 8 Riggs




Figure 8. Mary⁸ (Riggs) Shanks and Noah Shanks




Figure 9. James Buchanan⁹ Riggs




Figure 10. Greenberry⁹ Splawn




Figure 11. Bill of sale from Timothy⁵ Riggs to Silas⁶ Riggs, witnessed by Jacob⁶ Riggs, 4 Dec. 1804, Christian Co., Ky.
